Optional Units include: Schools as organisations, contribute to supporting bilingual learners, invigilate tests and examinations, prepare and maintain learning environments, provide displays in schools, support assessment for learning, support children and young people at meal or snack times, support children and young people's play and leisure, support children and young person's travel outside of the setting, support extra-curricular activities, support the use of information and communication technology for teaching and learning, move and position individuals in accordance with their plan of care and provide support for therapy sessions.
